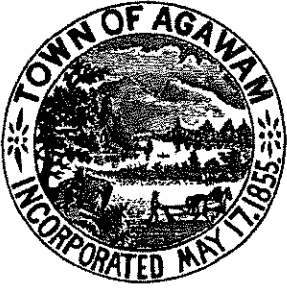

LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES January 23, 2018

The Agawam Liquor License Commission held their monthly meeting on Tuesday, January 23, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at the Agawam Public Library, 750 Cooper St., Agawam, MA. Chairman Kenneth Largay, Commissioners Vin Ronghi and Howard Safford and secretary, Maggie McCarthy were in attendance.

Minutes from the December 20, 2017 meeting were approved and accepted.

A Public Hearing was held for a transfer of license from Nangia, Inc. dba The Garden, 1422 Main St., Agawam to Chagnon, Inc. dba Lineage Italian Bistro, Teraesa Chagnon, manager, 525 Springfield St. Jennifer Chagnon, Teraesa Chagnon and Attorney Paul Maleck were in attendance to represent Lineage Italian Bistro. Teraesa plans to be on-site 40+ hours per week, the establishment has a small backroom to hold special events (capacity 25). The owners intend to run a "classy, dignified" restaurant and offer wine and beer pairings with food. Application was approved unanimously.

Discussion was held regarding a request received from Brick Stone Tavern for the Commissioners to reconsider their decision not to renew Brick Stone's liquor license for 2018. The Commissioners unanimously agreed that they have made the correct decision and have given Brick Stone ample time and multiple opportunities to get their establishment up and running. They will not reconsider their decision or hold a public hearing.
