FY 2018 Agawam Community Development Fund Application

The Agawam City Council will conduct a Public Hearing on February 5, 2018 at 7:00 PM at the Roberta Doering School, 68 Main Street, Agawam, MA to discuss the town's proposed FY18 Community Development Fund Application. The application will be filed no later than March 2, 2018. The Pioneer Valley Planning Commission (PVPC) is assisting the city with this application.

Residents are encouraged to attend this meeting to discuss the FY18 application to the MA Department of Housing and Community Development for up to \$800,000 in available Community Development Block Grant Funds. All persons with questions or comments regarding the grant application will have an opportunity to be heard. Those unable to attend can send written comments to the Office of Planning and Community Development, Town Hall – 36 Main Street, Agawam, MA 01001, Attn: Marc Strange, Planning and Community Development Director.

Projects currently being discussed include the Housing Rehabilitation Program, Aging in Place Housing Program, and Town Hall Architectural Barrier Removal Design.
