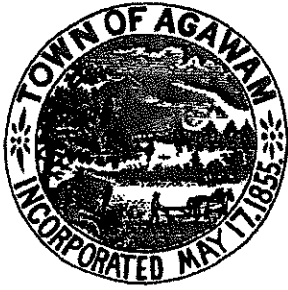

The Agawam Liquor License Commission held their monthly meeting on Wednesday, February 21, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at the Agawam Public Library, 750 Cooper St., Agawam, MA. Chairman Kenneth Largay, Commissioners Vin Ronghi and Howard Safford and secretary, Maggie McCarthy were in attendance.

Minutes from the January 23, 2018 meeting were approved and accepted.

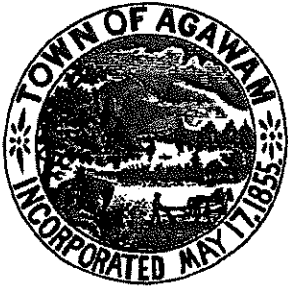
A public hearing was held for an application received for a transfer of an all alcohol liquor license from Valenti's Restaurant, 1 Cooper St., Joseph D. Valenti, manager, to Rayonia, Inc. dba The Indian Restaurant, 1422 Main St., Perparime Abdullahu, manager. Raj Rayonia, Perparime Abdullahu, Attorney David Bartley and Joseph Valenti were all in attendance. Attorney Bartley mentioned that the porch was to be used as well as the current establishment, 3 tables for a total occupancy of 12. The commissioners advised them to update the floor plan to include this porch area and the application was approved unanimously.

A public hearing was held for an application received for a transfer of a wine/malt/cordial liquor license from New King Yen Restaurant, Inc., 340 Springfield St. to Cigar Room, II, LLC, 51 Springfield St., Karin Tranghese, manager. Karin Tranghese and Attorney Ben Coyle were in attendance. Of concern to the commissioners was that the initial request was only to cover the 2nd floor of the establishment, It was suggested that Ms. Tranghese include the first floor as well in the event that they were to hold a function or party there. Ms. Tranghese agreed with the suggestion and the transfer of license for the entire establishment was approved unanimously.

Mr. Rizos was told that he needed to supply a "Certificate of Good Standing" for the A.B.C.C. and the pledge of license was approved unanimously.
