The Agawam Liquor License Commission held their monthly meeting on Wednesday, March 21, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at the Agawam Public Library, 750 Cooper St., Agawam, MA. Chairman Kenneth Largay, Commissioners Vin Ronghi and Howard Safford and secretary, Maggie McCarthy were in attendance.

Discussion was held with John G. Kudlic regarding the status of his liquor license for The Headquarters, 485 Springfield St., Feeding Hills, MA. The last time Mr. Kudlic came before the board he had stated that he was in the process of building a seafood restaurant and planned to move the license there. Today Mr. Kudlic stated that he is in the process of selling his license and when asked he told the board that he was selling to a Robert Manning, the owner of the Agawam Axe House on Main Street.

Mr. Largay informed the other commissioners that Six Flags is once again planning on holding their annual Beer Fest and while they are licensed for such activities the board appreciates being kept up-to-date.

Discussion was held regarding a request from Attorney Jeremy Powers who represents Brick Stone Tavern, Inc. Mr. Powers would like an opportunity to appear at the April liquor license meeting to hopefully amicably resolve the matter of Brick Stone's revoked liquor license before appealing to the A.B.C.C. The commissioners question the "seriousness" of such a request as they have yet to see an owner or attorney appear before them at a meeting.
