LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES April 18, 2018

The Agawam Liquor License Commission held their monthly meeting on Wednesday, April 18, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at the Agawam Public Library, 750 Cooper St., Agawam, MA 01001. Chairman Kenneth Largay, Commissioner Vin Ronghi and secretary, Maggie McCarthy were in attendance.

The meeting was brought to order at 6:32 p.m. and minutes from the February 2018 and March 2018 meetings were approved and accepted.

Discussion was held with Matthew Gibbs, manager at Catch 1251, 1251 River Road. Mr. Gibbs would like to use the upstairs at his establishment. He would also like to have seating on his outside patio, this would require an alteration of premises to include serving alcohol on the patio. It was explained to Mr. Gibbs that he would need to submit an application to the local board and upon their approval it would be forwarded to the ABCC in Boston.

The Commissioners voted to rescind the vote to revoke the liquor license at Brick Stone Tavern, 241 South Westfield St., Feeding Hills. This is the last "good faith attempt" to transfer this license rather than revoke it. The vote was approved unanimously with the stipulation that if it is not approved by the ABCC it would be placed on next month's agenda for revocation.

A public hearing was held for an application received for a transfer of license from Brick Stone Tavern, 241 South Westfield St., Feeding Hills to Teresa's Enterprises, Inc. dba Towne Tap Room, 378 Walnut St., Ext., Agawam, MA. Louis Bonavita, manager, was in attendance and answered any questions or concerns from the Commissioners. Mr. Bonavita will be on site 30-40 hours a week, capacity at the Tap Room will be 75 and no outside patio. Transfer was approved unanimously pending approval to rescind the vote for Brick Stone Tavern by the ABCC.

A public hearing was held for an application received for a change of location for The Still, Inc from 858 Suffield St., to 63 Springfield St. Becky Maslar, manager, was in attendance. Ms. Maslar is aware that the increase in size of the establishment would require good doormen and security protocol, she has confidence in her staff. Commissioners also spoke to Ms. Maslar regarding sprinklers (already installed), adding a fence and increasing her liquor liability insurance. Application was approved unanimously.
