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LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

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The Agawam Liquor License Commission held their monthly meeting on Wednesday, December 19, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at the Agawam Public Library, 750 Cooper St., Agawam, MA 01001. Chairman Kenneth Largay, Commissioners Vin Ronghi and Howard Safford and secretary, Maggie McCarthy were in attendance.

A public hearing was held for an application received for a change of manager at the American Legion – Post 185, 478 Springfield Street, from Donna Mancini to Andrew Pajak. Mr. Pajak was in attendance and stated that he is a lifetime member of the Club and would be on the premises at least 30 hours per week. He would like to see more community functions held there and plans to work for this to happen. Change of manager approved unanimously.

A public hearing was held for an application received for a change of manager at The Garden Restaurant, 1422 Main Street, from Perparime Abdullahu to Rajesh Rayonia. Mr. Rayonia stated that he would be on the premises 40 hours per week. There were no concerns and the application was approved unanimously.

A discussion was held with Wendy Markham owner of “Topsy Paintbrush”. She would like to operate a paint and sip establishment in town and be able to allow BYOB. As this is typically allowed for restaurants with a food license, the Commissioners explained that they would research this practice and let her know if it can be done.

A discussion with Robert Manning, manager of POUR, 485 Springfield St., who was asked to keep the Board updated with the status of progress at his establishment.

Liquor Licenses for 2019 were reviewed and signed.

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
