Mr. Kozloski called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

1. PUBLIC HEARING – Request for Determination – M Street – City of S

Jessica Roberts from Tighe and Bond was in attendance to present the RDA for the Bondi Island cell 2 vertical expansion. Ms. Roberts stated that all the work proposed is within the limit of work and will not be in the flood plain or the buffer zone. The flood insurance study profile cross section shows the lowest elevation at 132 feet, with the flood plain at 60 feet. Ms. Roberts stated the project will be utilizing the liners and storm water controls from a previously permitted expansion. There will be no change to the existing footprint.

Motion was made by Ms. Messick and seconded by Mr. Meagher to issue a Negative Determination of Applicability for the vertical expansion of cell 2 at Bondi's Island on M. Street.
