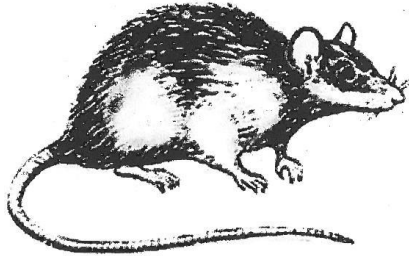

Rodent Abatement for Demolition Projects



In order to obtain a demolition permit through the Department of Inspectional Services, the Agawam Health Department requires you to obtain proof of rodent abatement from a licensed pest control technician. The reason why the Health Department requires you to have this service performed is to prevent rodents from scattering to other properties in the neighbourhood when the structure and the ground are disturbed.

Any experienced pest control company will be familiar with this process. Your technician will place tamper resistant rodent stations around the property. After a few days they will return to check the bait to see if there is evidence of rodent activity. If there is no activity, the work may commence. If activity is observed, a treatment will be needed.

Once the rodent abatement service is completed, your chosen pest control company will issue you a letter or invoice indicating they have performed the necessary work on the property and that the home or building is rodent (mouse and rat) free. Please provide a copy of the documentation to the Health Department as evidence you completed the required process for a demolition permit.
